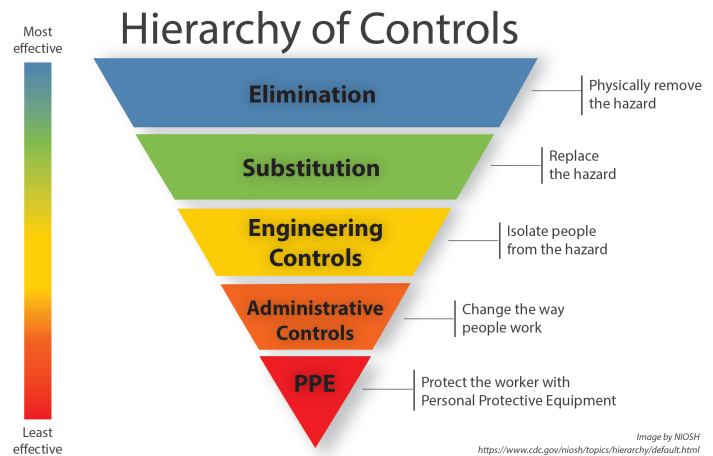




Take the Halt a Hazard Challenge!

Workplace hazards can emerge over time as business grows, a new product line is introduced, processes change, equipment or tools become worn, maintenance is neglected, or new staff onboard. Setting aside time to regularly identify and rank safeguards can help keep safety and health hazards under control and keep workers safe. Our challenge will help you identify and halt a hazard! Let's get started:

1. Identify ONE hazard to control within your workplace. Involve workers who often have the best understanding of the conditions that create this hazard.
2. Brainstorm potential controls. Use OSHA's **Identifying Hazard Control Options: The Hierarchy of Controls** ([osha.gov](https://www.osha.gov)) factsheet and worksheet. This approach will help you determine which control(s) are most effective, feasible, and sustainable in your workplace.
3. Choose and implement which control(s) are most effective for your workplace. Fill in the Hierarchy of Controls worksheet to determine if any new hazards may be created by the controls.
