Signs and Symptoms of Exposure
Headache, dizziness, nausea & loss of coordination are indications of excessive exposure to vapors or spray mists.

Medical Conditions Generally Aggravated by Exposure: None generally recognized.

Emergency and First Aid Procedures

If inhaled - remove from exposure - restore breathing - keep warm and quiet. If on skin - wash affected area thoroughly with soap & water. If in eyes - flush with large amounts of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

Steps to be Taken in Case Material is Released or Spilled

Remove all sources of ignition. Ventilate and remove with inert absorbent.

Waste Disposal Method

Incinerate in approved facility. Do not incinerate closed containers. Dispose of in accordance with Federal.

State and Local regulations regarding pollution.

Precautions to be Taken in Handling and Storing

Contents are combustible. Keep away from heat and open flame. Use approved bonding and grounding procedures.

Transfer only to approved, properly marked containers.

Other Precautions

Keep out of reach of children. Intentional misuse by deliberately inhaling the contents can be harmful or fatal.
