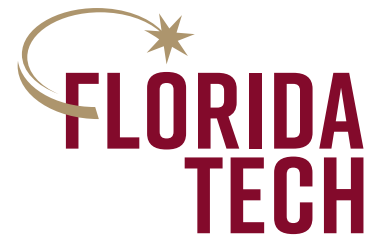

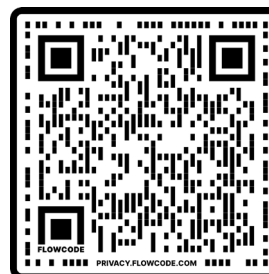

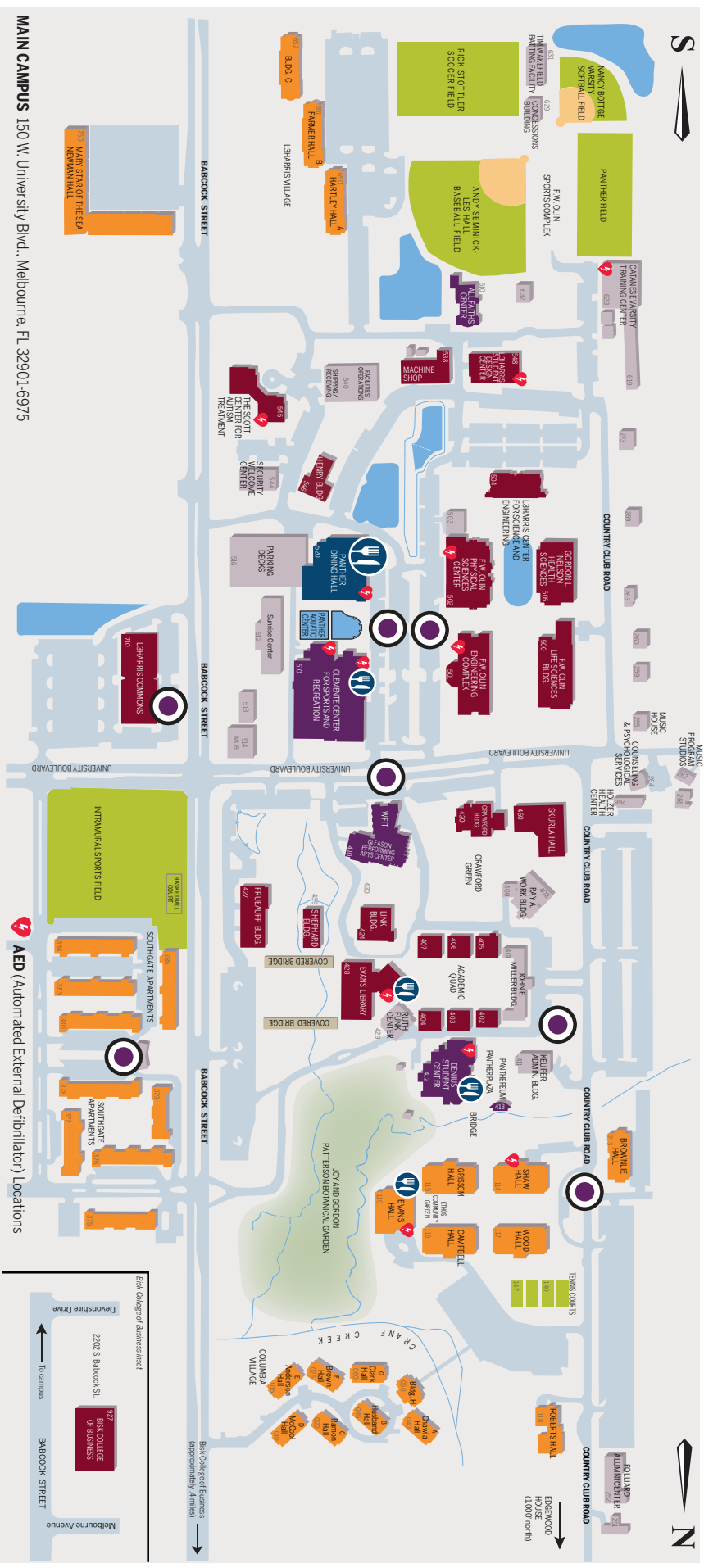

Larsen Motorsports
2495 Palm Bay Road NE, Palm Bay, FL 32905

From campus, take Babcock Street south approximately 2 miles, turn left (east) onto Palm Bay Road. Continue on Palm Bay Road approximately 1.5 miles. The entrance to Larsen Motorsports will be on the left (north) side of the road, just before the intersection of R.J. Conlan Boulevard.

From campus, take Babcock Street north approximately 1 mile, turn left (west) onto Hibiscus Boulevard. Turn right (south) on Woody Burke Drive. Continue straight through the intersection at NASA Boulevard. Turn left (west) on Grumman Place, then right (north) on Tower Access Road. The parking lot for FIT Aviation will be on the right.
