
Live Green Energy Challenge

In academic year 2016-17, <u>Florida Tech Residence Life</u>, in collaboration with the Facilities Operations Office and the Department of Education and Interdisciplinary Studies implemented an energy conservation initiative called the *Live Green Energy Challenge*.

Spearheaded by students as a pilot program in *Wood, Campbell,* and *Roberts Residence Halls,* the Live Green Energy Challenge is designed to help save on energy cost and CO₂ emissions.

With just three buildings attempting the challenge between August 2016 and May 2017, the result was the saving of over 145,500 lbs. of atmospheric CO₂ emissions and enough energy to power seven average homes for an entire year. Total electrical consumption decreased by 5.26%.



With all residence halls involved in this challenge for 2017-18, we expect to see even more energy cost savings along with a greener footprint for our campus!
