## Florida Institute of Technology Civic Engagement Initiative Policy



### Community Service

#### Definition

Community Service is defined as a person or group who provides aid or services to a community outside of the Florida Institute of Technology Campus Community. These services must be approved and recognized organizations by the Florida Institute of Technology Student Life Office.

#### Requirements

1. Must be an approved organization (including non-profit and church) by the Student Life Office.
2. Must benefit any community outside of the Florida Institute of Technology Community.

### Campus Service

#### Definition

Campus Service is defined as a person or group who provides aid or services to the Florida Institute of Technology Campus Community approved by the Student Life Office.

#### Requirements

1. Must be an approved event by the Student Life Office.
2. Cannot be an event put on by an organization where their only purpose is this one campus service event. If the person or group is not apart of the organization or apart of the planning the campus service event, the participants may count the service with approval of the Student Life Office.

Examples:

- a. Homecoming and all events included
- b. College Players' Plays
- c. Campus Active Board (CAB) events

### Philanthropy

#### Definition

Philanthropy is defined as a person or group who donates money or property to an approved and recognized organization by the Florida Institute of Technology Student Life Office.

#### Requirements

1. Must be an approved organization (including non-profit and church) by the Student Life Office.
2. Must be in dollar amounts at "fair market value."
3. Cannot count hours worked during the philanthropic process.
