

Scholarship assistance is considered for both undergraduate and graduate students and is based on academic merit and demonstrated financial need.

International applicants for **bachelor's** degree programs who apply before January 15 and meet the minimum criteria for the Florida Tech Scholarship program will automatically be considered for an award. Bachelor's degree applicants who do not meet the minimum criteria for the Florida Tech Scholarship program or need additional financial support may be eligible for a Florida Tech Grant by completing the information requested below.

Applicants for a **master's or doctoral** degree are considered for a scholarship on a rolling basis and are encouraged to apply considerably in advance of the admission application deadlines. Students who are awarded a Florida Tech Scholarship and a Graduate Assistantship (apply directly to the academic department) may choose between either award. Students may not receive both.

All international students are encouraged to secure scholarships from external sources to help fund their education in the United States. Additionally, students may apply for on-campus employment and are permitted to work up to 20 hours per week.
