1. Student information sheet (on page 2)

3. A transcript of all collegiate studies thus far. You can print this out yourself. No need for an official school transcript.
4. A \$300 nonrefundable registration fee made payable to Florida Institute of Technology. This fee covers Oxford expenses.

It is preferred that all information be typed or printed neatly.

Students must be in good academic and disciplinary standing with Florida Tech to participate in this program. Checks should be made payable to Florida Institute of Technology. The Office for Study Abroad will not accept cash.

Hand deliver applications to Crawford, Suite 103. Spaces are limited, so apply early to ensure your spot.
