

**Minutes: 10/31/08 Undergraduate Curriculum Committee (UGCC) Meeting
(amended at 4:44 p.m. 10/31/08)**

The following items were approved:

- Adding a New Course - PSY 2000 (Lifespan Development and Psychology)
- Changing Restrictions or Credits – PSY 2512

Background was presented and discussion took place regarding the appropriate use of ASC 1051 (Chemistry Review) and the possibility of adding CHM 1100 as a co-requisite. Rodd Newcombe, Director of Academic Support, characterized the current use of ASC 1051. To address a broader challenge, it was decided that 1) Veronica Giguere, Associate Director of Academic Support, will try to develop an eight-week version of ASC 1005 (Strategies for Success at Florida Tech) and 2) a new ASC course (0???) will be developed that can be used in connection with academic review for any discipline and will replace ASC 1051. It will be a 1-credit course that does not count toward graduation.
