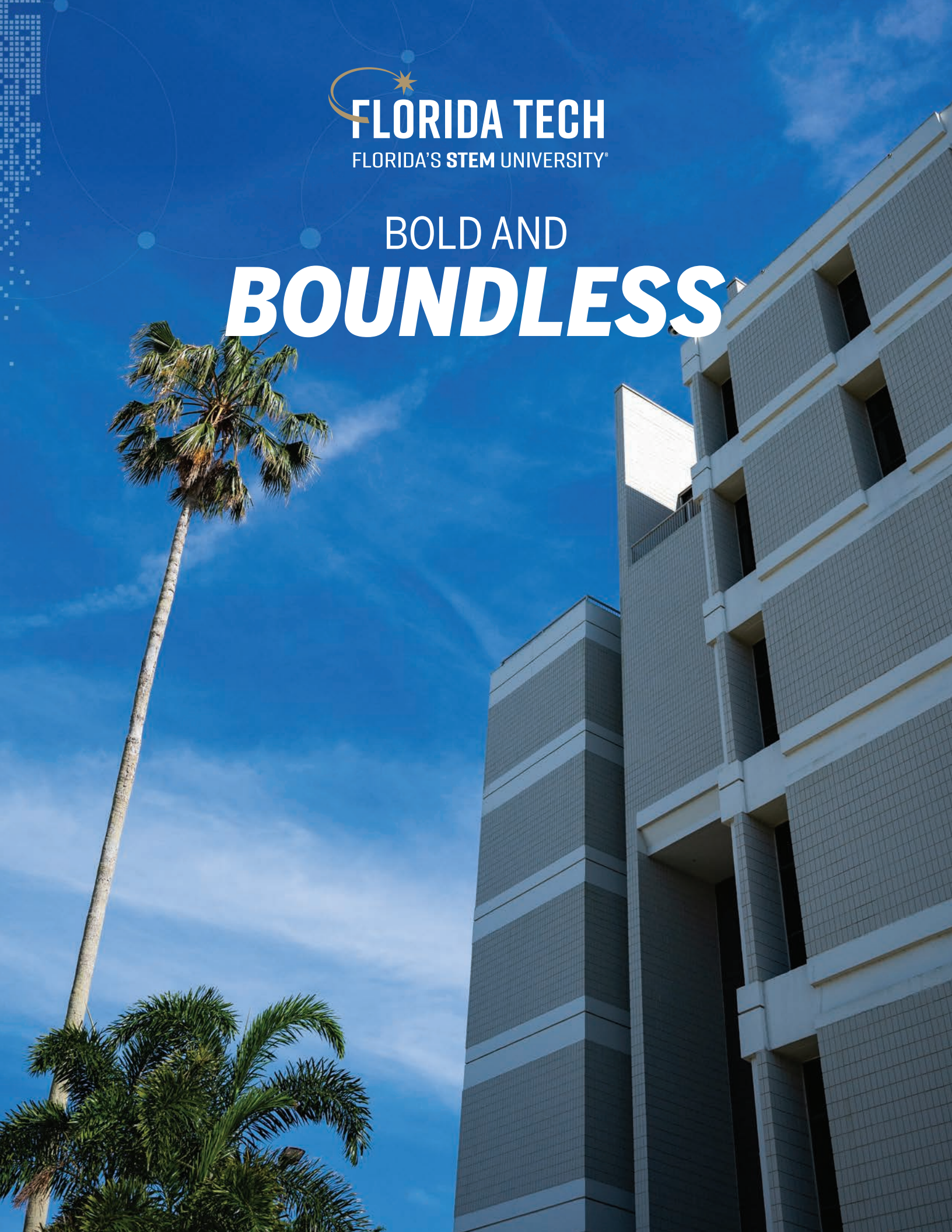

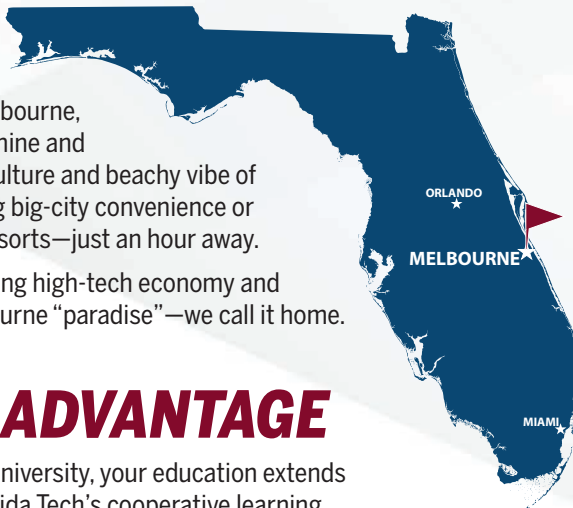




Where We Are

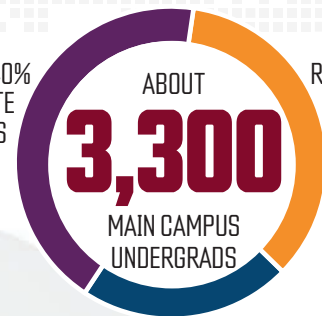

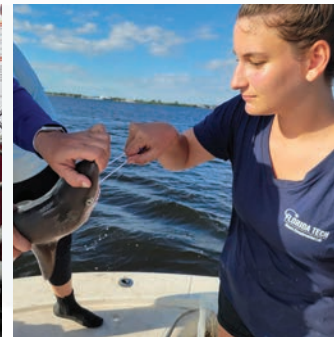

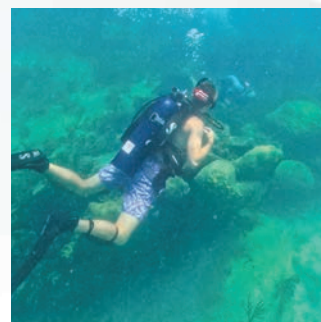
Learning Adventures

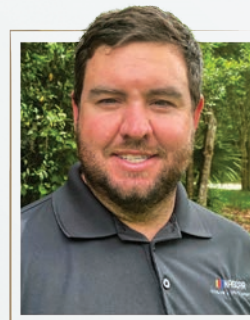

First, choose your major. We directly admit students into academic programs at Florida Tech, so we need to know what you’re passionate about.

Then, fill out and submit your application. You have two options:

- Common Application™—commonapp.org

Finally, provide these supporting documents:

- High school and/or college transcripts
- ACT, SAT or CLT scores
