I. Old Business

a. Approval of Minutes, 12/05/13.

--Minutes approved by unanimous vote.

b. Update from various program areas on assessment.

CK: (Mathematics) Math has all data entered. The Algebra class did poorly – only 39% met or exceeded target. This might be due to those classes not having access to MAC lab. MR suggested that this result might provide impetus to make the lab accessible to those students as well.

MR: Reminder that our target date is now March 2014. Not sure what date in March.

VG: (Computer Literacy) 2012 data are entered. May also have 2011 data in as well.

JO: (Physical Science) 2011 – current data are entered for the Chemistry portion.

None of the others have been entered yet (as of yesterday).

MR: I have to check with Andy to discuss the other science departments.

ML: (Psychology) Entries are still ongoing.

AV: We need to include EEC2303 as well as BUS2303 for assessment purposes since the EEC course generates assessment data as well. So this needs to be adjusted in WEAVE. MR will follow up on this issue.

c. GEDRC policy and and procedures document: approval?

MR: Document has been sent out a couple of cycles ago. Does not need a vote approval as long as no committee members have disagreements.

II. New Business

a. Discussion of including Aeronautics into GE Program review.

MR: Andy said he is working on it. We are working on getting an Aero rep on this committee.

b. WEAVE entry for Spring, Summer, Fall 2014.

MR: Think about your spring 2014 data entry. You shouldn't be waiting until May to get these data entered.

CK: Voiced concern regarding requiring faculty to work over summer. MR suggested that these entries might be made at the beginning of the fall 2014 semester.
