**SOURCES OF SUPPORT**

F-2 dependent spouses and children are not permitted to work under any circumstances. J-2 Exchange Visitor dependents may apply for employment authorization from U.S. Citizenship & Immigration Services. Funds from J-2 employment may not, however, be used to support the Exchange Visitor and his/her family. The request for work authorization must clearly document family finances/expenses and affirm that the J-2 dependent is seeking work permission for other reasons (i.e., professional development, money for travel, etc.).
