Students admitted to the program earn college credit from a prestigious national, doctoral-granting research university at no cost to them. Additional benefits include:

- Hands-on, college-level experience in science, engineering, business, aeronautics, psychology and liberal arts while still in high school
- Enhanced credentials prior to applying for admission to four-year universities
- Access to stellar faculty and state-of-the-art research and laboratories
- Guaranteed admission to a Florida Tech degree program if you complete at least 6 semester credit hours and achieve a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher in your courses at Florida Tech

Entrance Requirements

To enter the P2P Academy, interested students must submit the following to PBMHS:

- EPO magnet application for nonzoned students.
- Academic records.

• A minimum of two teacher recommendations.

• A one-page, properly formatted essay that outlines why the student feels they will be a good fit for the program.

Prior to the end of their sophomore year, students in the P2P Academy must meet Florida Tech's dual enrollment requirements, which can be found at floridatech.edu/dual-enrollment.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Successful completion of the P2P Academy will require the following of the student:

- Scoring a min. of 1100 on SAT in March of Sophomore year
- Retention of a cumulative 3.0 unweighted GPA throughout all four years of the program.

While at the high school, students must take academically rigorous coursework in core academic classes.
