

ORIENTATION

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All **DOMESTIC STUDENTS** MUST bring some form of a picture ID and their printed Panther Pass with them to check-in.
 All **INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS** MUST bring their passport, I-20 and their printed Panther Pass with them to check-in.
ALL STUDENTS (regardless of whether they have registered or not) will need to check in on Thursday. All students will be required to complete Panther Pass and bring a printed pass with them to check-in.
 Upon arrival, students will be provided with a checklist of items that will need to be completed to ensure they are ready for classes. The process can take as little as 20 minutes or as long as five hours, depending on the status of Panther Pass.
