

Students who wish to be considered for the Oxford Summer Study Abroad Program should complete this application, scan and email it to hwautlet@fit.edu. The nonrefundable \$300 program registration fee should be paid into the Oxford Program account at the Student Accounts window on the first floor of the L3Harris Commons Building on Babcock Street. If you are not on main campus, payments can be made by phone. Contact the program director for guidance. Scan and email the receipt to hwautlet@fit.edu along with your application. The \$300 registration fee will be refunded only to those students who are not selected for the program (due to academic standing, etc.).

1. Student information sheet (on page 2)
2. A brief one- or two-paragraph, typed statement: "How will studying abroad benefit you?"
3. A transcript of all collegiate studies thus far. You can print this out yourself from PAWS. No need for an official school transcript.
4. A \$300 nonrefundable registration fee made payable to Florida Institute of Technology. This fee covers Oxford expenses.

Once your application is received, you will be notified via email within two weeks of the status of your application.

Spaces are limited, so apply early to ensure your spot.
